

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"I'm going fishing with Ra today," said Dad.


"I like going fishing," said Kiri.

"I want to come with you, too," said Kiri.




"You are too little to go fishing with Dad and me," said Ra.

They went on fishing.


"Look!" shouted Kiri.
"A fish! Look at this fish!"


"Wow, it is a big fish," said Ra.
